



Dear St. Joseph Families,
At St. Joseph we encourage our families to be involved in the life of the Church. During Lent, we are called to increase the practice of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. This is done in order to journey more closely with our Lord throughout the Lenten season. If you glance to the right, you will see that we are working with the St. Vincent DePaul Society to help feed the hungry in our local community. Each Friday, students can bring in items requested to their homeroom class. As you can see, the first item is canned fruit. Thank you in advance for your

kindness and consideration.
I ask that you put in prayer all of our students who are on the tail-end of the journey towards the Sacraments of initiation. First, we have about 5 students (and a parent) who will enter the Church at the Easter Vigil.
