

Your child may be eligible for a K-12 private school scholarship

ARETE SCHOLARS provides private K-12 scholarships exclusively to qualifying low-to-moderate-income students. The scholarships empower parents who otherwise have limited options to select a school that best meets their child's unique gifts, talents, and learning needs.

Maximum scholarship amounts: \$4,427 for grades K-8; or \$4,980 for grades 9-12.

Application period: March 3, 2026–May 1, 2026 (please check the website for deadline updates)

Note: Applications are first-come, first-served, with priority given to returning Arete students.

To be eligible for a scholarship in Louisiana, a student must meet the following income, residency, and prior school year requirements:

1. Louisiana resident, *AND*
2. Enrolled in Louisiana public school for 2025-26, *OR*
3. Entering kindergarten in 2026-27, *OR*
4. Received a TDC award in 2025-26, *AND*
5. Family income less than the following maximum amounts:

2 People	54,100
3 People	68,300
4 People	82,500
5 People	96,700
6 People	110,900
7 People	125,100
8 People	139,300


