The first \$100,000 raised across our three events is split 50 / 40 / 10 between Falcon Fest, the PTO Soirée, and the Dads Club's Falcon Shoot Out. Falcon Fest is a no-profit event — its \$50,000 goes toward hosting it, and its purpose is building community within the school and surrounding neighborhoods rather than raising money for purchases. For the Soirée, its \$40,000 puts on the event — including a silent auction, which separately raises money from guests that is not part of the \$164,000 PIE total. This year the auction netted \$64,000, funding the PTO items at right, including student and staff enrichment events. The Falcon Shoot Out's \$10,000 PIE split similarly seeds the event, which netted \$12,000 this year toward gymnasium lighting, the storage container, and the front entrance signage. Everything raised beyond the first \$100,000 — \$64,000 this year — goes directly to the school with no event in between, covering cost-to-educate support, the boiler room roof replacement, gymnasium storage reorganization, and the school's greatest remaining needs. ★ marks projects still in progress.
